90-DAY PRESCRIPTION DRUG RETAIL BENEFIT

Effective April 1, 2017, you will be able to fill your long-term maintenance prescription drugs for a 90-day supply at most major chain pharmacies and many independent pharmacies. These 90-day prescription drug requests will be processed at the same rates as mail-order prescription drug requests. This means that you will pay the same co-pay amounts for these retail prescription drugs as you do for mail-order drugs:

You pay the following co-pays directly to the participating retail pharmacy or mail order

Generics	0%
Formulary brands	20%
Non-formulary brands	30%, minimum \$40 for 30-day supply, \$80 for 90-day supply
Co-payment after out-of-pocket limit of \$1,000 per calendar year per person has been met	0%
